The AGM is at 2.45pm in the South Transept and will be followed by our special Guest Speaker, Dr Victoria Avery. As well as being an expert in her field Vicky is a Life Friend of Ely Cathedral! Tea follows at 4.45pm before Festal Evensong at 5.30pm.

Guest Speaker: Dr Victoria Avery

Dr Victoria Avery FSA is Keeper of Sculpture & Decorative Arts at the Fitzwilliam Museum, University of Cambridge, and was previously Associate Professor in the History of Art Department, University of Warwick. While her subject specialism is Italian Renaissance Sculpture, Vicky has a broad-ranging knowledge across the decorative arts field. She has co-curated several award-winning exhibitions including Treasured Possessions (2015), Madonnas & Miracles (2017) and Feast & Fast (2019). Her new exhibition focuses on enslavement and resistance and the Cambridge University Museums' collections and their links to the Black Atlantic. Vicky has been a member of Ely Cathedral's congregation since 2010, and a Lay Canon and Member of Chapter from 2017 until recently.
