



A Christingle includes an orange.	Its round shape represents the earth.
A red ribbon or piece of tape is wrapped around the orange.	The red colour represents the blood of Jesus.
The ribbon wrapped around the orange also shows the love of Jesus wrapped all around the earth.	Four cocktail sticks are stuck around the top of the orange, above the red ribbon or tape.
The cocktail sticks are evenly placed around the orange, like the compass directions.	There are sweets or dried fruit on the cocktail sticks.
The fruit or sweets on the cocktail sticks represent the way that God provides for us.	The cocktail sticks represent the 4 seasons.
A candle is placed in the middle of the orange	The candle is lit during a Christingle service, though many churches do now use glow sticks.
When lit, the candle represents Jesus as the light of the world.	

Print this sheet onto card and cut out to create a set of small cards. Shuffle them and hand each student or small group (if you are able to work in groups under government restrictions) a set. They should use the cards to create a labelled Christingle – showing the different parts and their meaning.
